Woodworking– We maintain the most in-demand equipment capabilities and well-trained employees, with two main pieces of equipment: a computerized panel saw and CNC router.


Packaging & Assembly– From start to finish, we offer services such as collating, bagging and shrink-wrapping.



A Look Inside the L.E. Phillips Career Development Center

The L.E. Phillips Career Development Center is a community rehabilitation facility located in Eau Claire, Wisconsin. We strive to provide meaningful jobs for those individuals who might not otherwise find employment, while giving quality service to our customers. The CDC offers a wide variety of programs, coupled with services such as upholstery, sewing, graphic design, screen printing, woodworking, packaging and assembly.



On a yearly basis, the L.E. Phillips Career Development Center serves over one thousand individuals through programs services and manufacturing while maintaining our mission. The CDC was one of the first rehabilitation facilities for individuals in Wisconsin and it is the intention of the CDC to move grow and remain flexible to meet the needs of workers in the Chippewa Valley.

Our Programs

Skills Training– We offer specific training in many areas including forklift training, food service and all of our departments.

Career Passport– This document certifies that a participant has met specific academic and workplace competencies important for employment.

Vocational Evaluation– This program's purpose is to identify and measure vocational strengths and weaknesses and how they relate to an individual's vocational potential.

Job Placement– This program provides placement services to all clients who achieve sufficient work skills and/or habits that enable them to maintain employment at a different level.

Work Adjustment– This program offers individuals the opportunity to focus on and improve work tolerances and stamina. It also address attitudes, work habits and acceptable workplace behaviors.

Extended Employment– This is a long-term employment and training program.

Corporate Guardianship– This program provides guardianship services for up to 125 individuals in West-Central Wisconsin that have no close family or other support systems who need legal protection.

Skills to Pay the Bills– This program helps youth and adults to learn the soft skills and workforce readiness skills.

Chippewa County Homeless Services Outreach Office

We provide:

- Emergency Shelter Assistance
- Housing Counseling
- Referrals to external services and supports
- One-to-one assistance to at-risk individuals

Tenant Based Rental Assistance. Our goal is to diminish need and reliance upon rental assistance through:

- Assisting in increasing earned and/or non-earned income
- Providing referrals for outside supports in relation to food, gas, clothing, school, financial aid, household needs, employment, medical care, etc.
- Increasing natural supports for individuals and families
- Advocating for families and individuals who seek our services

- Cleaning Supplies
- Linens
