L.E. PHILLIPS CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER AWARDED RAM AND INSPECTOR'S AWARD

EAU CLAIRE, Feb 22, 2018- The L.E. Phillips Career Development Center has been cleaning and maintaining three wayside rest areas and one historical marker in Wisconsin for more than 20 years. This year, CDC was awarded the 2017 Inspector's Award and the Rehabilitation And Maintenance Award, signed by Governor Scott Walker.

On February 21, State Inspector Robert Marshcke presented the Inspector's Award to CDC's waysides team. This is the first year with the new crew of Scott Kulig, Dan Ferron and Alex Grill. The State Inspector chooses whom he presents the award to and it is not awarded every year. Marshcke also gave pins for Pursuit of Excellence to the waysides team, CEO Gregg Mizerk, Director of Production Deborah Creaser-Kipp and Accountant Sharri Olsen.

CDC is responsible for cleaning and mowing the waysides weekly and then building maintenance as needed, such as roofs, all aspects of lawn care, sidewalks, curbing, weed control and trimming of trees.

Marshcke said, "To show you how good these guys were, they didn't have to respond, they were way ahead of the game. They were calling me and telling me this needs to be done, can we do it? I usually don't get that and they were fantastic, I didn't have to worry about them... this is my final year and the best people I have ever had to work with!"
